Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been lovely recently to experience the warmer weather and lighter evenings. With the better weather I know that the children have really appreciated the opportunity this week to once again play on our school field. As always, it is such a pleasure to see them playing and socialising, both at break and lunchtime, in such a positive and respectful manner. The summer term is always a special time in the life of the school. During this term many of our children will be going away on residential trips to Land and Wave, Rockley, Bude and Paris. At St Osmund's we highly value the benefits of these trips, from so many different perspectives. For many of our children the memories and friendships that they will make on these trips will stay with them for many years to come.

We are also at a time of year when children throughout the country will shortly be taking national exams or assessments. In the week beginning Monday 13th May our children in Year 6, alongside all children nationally, will undertake end of Key Stage 2 assessments, commonly referred to as SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) in reading, spelling, punctuation, grammar and maths. The tests are designed to help measure the attainment of pupils in relation to the standards set out in the national curriculum, and help teachers and parents identify where pupils may need additional support in a certain subject area. There are no tests for English writing or science, at the end of Key Stage 2, instead Year 6 teachers will make a judgement based on each child's overall work and performance. As with the tests, these judgements will help to indicate if a child requires more support in the subject. Schools throughout the country will receive the results of the end of Key Stage 2 SATs at the beginning of July. In the week beginning Monday 11th June students in Year 8 will sit externally produced and marked assessments in maths and English. We look forward to sharing the results of the end of Key Stage 2 SATs and Year 8 GL progress tests, as part of our end of year reports

Finally, just a date for your diary. On the 7th June we will be holding our summer music festival "Ossie's Fest 2024", which promises to be another exciting event in the school calendar, featuring a Ceilidh band, student performances, and an open mic, alongside a BBQ and cocktail bar. We have already secured £2,000 of sponsorship for the festival and are extremely grateful to Deane Computer Solutions, Thomson Interiors Ltd., James Newsam Construction, Hunt's Food Group and Charminster Stores and Post Office for their generous sponsorship.


If you are interested in making a dish for the day (the more the merrier) please take an ingredients list from the registers or come to Miss Watters' room (room 5) and collect one.

CAN YOU HELP?

In the week beginning Monday 13th May, the children in Year 6 will take national curriculum assessments, or 'SATs' as they are sometimes referred to, in English grammar, punctuation and spelling, English reading and mathematics.

The tests help measure the attainment of pupils, in relation to standards set out in the national curriculum, and help teachers and parents identify where pupils may need additional support in a certain subject area.

The tests are scheduled to take place on the following days:

- Monday 13th May English grammar, punctuation and spelling
- Tuesday 14th May English reading
- Wednesday 15th May Mathematics
- Thursday 16th May Mathematics



We are seeking volunteers to assist the teachers in the class to administer these tests. This will involve a commitment of approximately two to three hours on each of the four days (Monday, Tuesday and Thursday between 8.40 and 10.50 and on Wednesday from 8.40 to 11.40) and attendance on a training session on either Tuesday 23rd April or Wednesday 24th April from 3.30 to 4.30.

We would be very grateful to parents/carers/relations, who have got children in any of the four year groups who are available to support the school at this time.




