Pupil Behaviour Contract

Below you will find the trip expectations that all pupils must adhere to during their visit to France. I'm sure you will agree that the safety and enjoyment of everyone on the trip is paramount and these expectations have been put in place to ensure that this happens. Before we leave for Paris, you and your child are required to read through this contract. This confirms that yourself as parent/carer and your child understand and agree to abide by the expectations below and are aware that should any of these be broken and a resolution cannot be met, the child will be asked to leave the centre and you as parent/carer will be fully responsible for their collection from the hotel and journey home. St Osmund's will not reimburse any travelling expenses incurred in doing this nor will you be able to claim any reimbursement for the shortened duration of their visit to France.

Paris Trip Expectations

No anti-social behaviour – Any actions that negatively affect the safety or enjoyment of themselves or others.

No bringing or using mobile phones, tablets, smart watches or any electronic equipment that has access to the internet.

No leaving the hotel unsupervised or leaving their walking group except when given clear permission. All instructions will be followed, and any time restrictions met.

No girls in boy's room or vice versa.

No vaping, smoking materials or alcohol to be brought on or used during the trip.

Follow all St. Osmund's adults' instructions; this is essential for a safe trip.

Please acknowledge that you have read, fully understand, agree to abide by the expectations laid out above and to collect your child from Paris should this be required. Please tick the appropriate box on the Paris Google form (sent to all parents via email).
