In the United Kingdom, the term county lines is a neologism referring to the practice of using children to traffic drugs into rural areas. In 2018, British police stated that they believed there were around 1,500 drug trafficking routes of this sort in the United Kingdom. There has been much in the media over the past few months reporting this growing trend and the concerns particularly to the young and the vulnerable.
