Dear Ossie's Families,

School life is not just about what happens inside the classroom but also all the wider, enrichment activities our pupils enjoy on a regular basis at St Osmund's:

This week was World Book Day – a wonderful celebration of reading for pleasure. Pupils in all year groups (and staff) enjoyed dressing up as their favourite story character as well as undertaking book-themed activities. Stories were shared, competitions and quizzes were tackled; and much fun was had by all! Every pupil has been provided with a book voucher which can be exchanged for one of this year's World Book Day books. Alternatively, these vouchers give a £1 discount off any book or audiobook with a value of £2.99 or more from participating book sellers. The closest retailers to the school where these vouchers can be exchanged are Tesco, Waterstones, The Works and WHSmith. This is such a great opportunity to discuss reading preferences with your child and encourage them to try a new author or different genre.

Coming up next Friday (15th March) is a further national event which we will be supporting at St Osmund's: Comic Relief. We are inviting all children to come to school dressed in non-school uniform for a suggested donation of £1. This event will give our pupils the opportunity to reflect on the recent collective worship themes of social issues and character awareness as well as consider our school values of hope, love, respect and community in a different context. On each non-uniform day we seek to support the national event and a local charity or organisation. The proceeds from next Friday will be divided; 50% to Comic Relief and 50% to Dorchester Youth and Community Centre.

On 20th March, Miss February-Perring will take a mix of pupils from across the school to the Dorchester Area Schools Collaborative Writing Competition. Pupils from Ossie's will have the opportunity to work with students of all ages from local schools to compose their own original stories. We are excited to read what they write!

Finally, an event which is being anticipated with much excitement amongst our pupils is the end of term 'Just the Two of Us' event. Microphones are being swapped for paddles this time around with pupils pairing up with staff for a pickleball tournament. This is both a fun and a fundraising event with all money raised going to Mosaic; a local bereavement charity. This event will take place in the last week of the spring term.



ROAD CLOSURES FROM MONDAY

As a school, we have just received a letter informing us that that, commencing **Monday 11**th **March**, there will be temporary road closures in South Court Avenue and part of Rothesay Road. There will be a diversion in place along Monmouth Road and Culliford Road. This is in order that the utility company can replace the old cast iron mains with new polyethylene plastic pipes, as part of an ongoing upgrade programme. It is possible that the planned temporary road closures might lead to traffic delays and therefore we would recommend allowing more time for your journey, if you are travelling to school at this time. The red line shows road closures, the blue line is the diversion.




ANXIETY, SELF-HARM & EATING DISORDER WEBINARS
